

Angels for the Garden have arrived!

Angels exist. These spiritual creatures of God are everywhere. And now – Catholic Cemeteries has two life-size representations of angels to remind us that angels really are with us.

Two beautiful bronze trumpeting angels were commissioned during late 2016 as part of the Garden of the Angels cremation garden development. They were designed and molded by Italian artisan. The Angels arrived in mid-2017 and were placed in storage while the foundations and pillars were erected. The Angels were elevated and secured to the pedestals at the end of August.

The Garden of the Angels, offering both premier in-ground cremation burial and above ground wall cremation niche space, is located in Resurrection Cemetery (west side of 78th and West Center Road) The garden is bordered by Holy Angels Mausoleum to the north and the large garden fountain to the south, and treed borders to the east and west. The mausoleum, where the monthly Memorial Mass is celebrated, can be entered from either the east or west sides of the garden.

The angels add significant beauty and appropriately reflect the naming of this area. While they will be enjoyed by all who drive by or stroll in the garden, an individual family may choose to memorialize their family legacy by sponsoring one of these fabulous works of art.
